Internet Web Site:

The South Florida United Internet site is located at www.sfuysa.com Players, coaches, volunteers, etc. are all able to access the latest schedules, standings, fields, events, etc. from links on this page. Game reporting and interclub communication via email is also available. Note that there are several areas of this site that are restricted from general use and users must provide an Id and password for access.

Unwanted spam has changed the delivery method of league generated emails. We can no longer send emails on behalf of logged-in users and ensure its delivery. Thus our notification emails are being changed to arise from the site administrator and not necessarily the person making the requests. The end result is that we cannot guarantee notification emails will be properly received by all parties. Users enter incorrect emails, or fail to update their club information and user profiles further decreasing the reliability and adding to the mailing overhead. Ultimately, web generated email should NOT be relied upon as the sole means of communicating changes and schedules to participants.

www.sfuysa.com/LgStandings.asp This league standings page is the primary start page for searching league standings. Listed by division are the complete standings for each division. Note that if a team has not played any games, that team will not show up in any standings. The team will however be listed on pages specific to that team or division listing upcoming games, etc.

www.sfuysa.com/LgTeams.asp The "league teams" page lists all teams participating in the current season in Club order. Links are provided to the team pages and to the division pages by selecting the respective team or division links.

www.sfuysa.com/declarations.asp This page lists all the teams and coaches participating in the league. It's content is reproduced at the back of the manual for your easy reference.

www.sfuysa.com/clubhome.asp?club=WES The clubhome.asp page lists all teams participating in the current season for the identified club. In the example link, the club code for Weston (WES) is used. On this page you can select a team to view current standings in that teams division as well as upcoming and recently played games. Note that this page is also accessible by clicking on the club code on the team home page.

You can type in the direct address for your team or navigate to your team's page from many other pages at the site. In the example link the Kendall Hammocks U17 (KHO701) is shown.

www.sfuysa.com/Venues.asp The Venues page lists all SFUYSA Field Venues. Select a venue to view the respective fields at that venue and to see a list of games scheduled there. Interactive driving directions to the fields and even a satellite image are available so you know exactly where you are going. A copy of the content of this page is also provided in this manual for ease of reference.

www.sfuysa.com/EventsM.asp The Events main page provides a calendar of soccer events. League administrators are able to create events for publication for a variety of area soccer happenings. Use the calendar to keep current on deadlines, etc.

The SFU web site is optimized for Microsoft Internet Explorer version 4+. We are currently rewriting much of the web site to make it more compatible with other browsers. In addition to MS Internet

Explorer, all users should download and install the Adobe Acrobat reader. Many of the documents on the site are provided in this format so that you can print them easily. Adobe's acrobat reader can be obtained from a link on the league's home page. Follow the three-step process for installation.

Schedule Changes:

Schedule changes are inevitable as a result of bad weather, unanticipated field closures, etc. However; the schedule of SFU games is considered **primary** compared to other events, tournaments, and outings. After the initial publishing of the schedule, Club Reps have one week to identify any problems that need to be corrected for their home games. During this period, Club Reps are able to submit requests for game time changes that will be automatically approved. Reps are encouraged to make these changes by sending a single email identifying all requested changes. This one-week period is used to modify games to accommodate referee assigning or to fix problems from already scheduled games etc. It is also during this week that Club Reps may request Division 2 games outside of Region A to be moved to back into Region A. If teams elect to move a Division 2 away game from outside of the Region, they **MUST** provide a field on the same date as the schedule date. Any requests made after the first week or for a different date, will be denied.

After the first week of schedule publishing, the following procedure should be followed when requesting schedule changes:

1) Only Reps or their alternates are to communicate with the Divisional VP's. However; if there is an emergency and you are unable to contact your representative, the Divisional VP's are there to assist you.

2) **Field-Only Changes** -- For changes of field location only, the burden is on the **home team**. Make sure the visitor knows of the change if possible at least 48 hours prior to game time. If there could be a problem, make sure there is someone at the old-field location to direct the team and referees to the new location.

3) **All other Changes** -- If there is a need to change the date or time of a game, you will need to reach an agreement with the other coach of a suitable alternate play date and time. Have your Club Representative confirm your agreement by contacting the other club's rep. Once an agreement is reached, the two club reps will be able to make the game modification in the web site directly. All modifications of this type **MUST BE COMPLETED AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE GAME DATE**. Thus, any Saturday game change request must be approved by **BOTH** parties by midnight on Thursday. Any changes desired after the deadline will be disallowed by the system and a Divisional VP will need to intercede. These types of changes will be the exception and not the rule and may not be granted. Such exceptions might include an unknown school trip requiring the presence a majority of team members. **TOURNAMENTS, OR OTHER NON-EDUCATIONAL, TRIPS, ETC. ARE NOT SUFFICIENT GROUNDS FOR RESCHEDULE REQUESTS**. However: if teams have previously indicated conflicts in their declarations that were not met, every effort will be made to honor those initial requests. Note that in addition to reaching an agreement with the opponent, there may be other individuals which must approve of such changes. The home club's assignor and field/site directors should be consulted throughout the process. Although the league allows for game changes to occur up to 24 hours in advance of the scheduled play date, there may be other agreements in place that would prohibit such changes. For example, if a local club's agreement with their assignor calls for no game changes outside of a 96 hour window, there is nothing the league will do to override that policy. Also, in order to effectuate such a change, some assignor contracts may make it necessary for referees to be paid for the original game as well as the newly scheduled game. All of these issues need to be discussed and agreed to prior to the deadline.

4) **GAME CHANGES NOT APPEARING ON THE WEB SITE ARE NOT APPROVED**. If you have reached an agreement with your opposing coach, but the web site does not indicate the new information, the change has not been officially approved by the league. Playing the game without official approval can result in forfeiture by both teams plus fines. Contact your rep to make sure when there is a question.

5) **Rainout Policy**

a) Coaches are **not** authorized to call off a game due to weather or field conditions. The job of determining field suitability for play falls upon the referee. However, if a parks department or field director has closed the field, a referee is not allowed to overrule that decision.

b) If threatening weather is expected or at hand, coaches should contact the field director to make sure the fields are not closed. They should also make sure to have contact numbers for the opposing coach, the assignor, and the referees if possible in order to make notification should conditions change.

c) Time Frames. Since teams may be traveling large distances in inclement weather, the following deadlines will be observed in notifying of game cancellations due to field CLOSURE.

- Teams traveling less than **60** Miles -- No game may be called off more than **2** hours prior to it's scheduled start time
- Teams traveling between **61 - 120** Miles -- No game may be called off more than **3** hours prior to it's scheduled start time
- Teams traveling more than **120** Miles -- No game may be called off more than **4** hours prior to it's scheduled start time

d) Referee Payments. If the referee has ruled the game to be a rainout prior to the game starting, each referee should be paid \$5 by the home team and the referee should complete a game report. Some clubs have assigning contracts that require full payment to referees. Should you be the visiting team at such a club, you are not required to pay the full amount for a rainout prior to the game's start. That burden is on the home team. However, if you are requesting a schedule change that will cause the home club to incur full referee fees, you may be required to pay those fees in order to achieve a rescheduling. The league will not interfere in such matters unless the change is the result of a restriction that was known prior to scheduling and unaccounted for.

e) Both coaches should report the rainout to their respective Club Reps and attempt to work out a make-up day and time. If a new make up day and time has not been arranged within one-week of play, the league may set a date as per the rules.

In the case where failure to follow the above policy has occurred and penalties result, mileage determinations will be made between each Club's registered address as submitted on the SFUYSA Club Information form. Please use this information as a guide. The information is intended to avoid the premature cancellations of games and loss of potential goodwill amongst the participants.

All teams must show up to scheduled games. Failure to show up will result in a fine of \$200 plus the costs of both teams referee fees and assigning costs.

No Show Procedure: If a Team A does not show up to a scheduled game, then Team B needs to pay the referee fees for both teams. The referee **MUST** complete a game report indicating the no-show and Team B needs to fax that report in to the League and report the score as a no show without a score. Team B's Club will be reimbursed all referee fees paid plus \$100 of the \$200 fine that was assessed to Team A. Under no circumstances will the League reimburse individual coaches for referee fee payments. Clubs are credited for the amounts and are responsible for reimbursing their coaches. **MAKE SURE TO GET A COPY OF THE REFEREE REPORT INDICATING THE NO SHOW!**

Game Reporting:

Club Reps are responsible for game reporting and should be the only persons using the Internet-based game reporting system. Note; we are no longer accepting faxed, or emailed game reports to the Divisional VP's for scoring purposes. Make sure you and your reps work out a system of reporting games scores so that they are completed by 5:00 pm on Tuesday following the play date. Failure to report scores in a timely fashion may result in forfeiture, fines, or both. **All coaches MUST keep a copy of ALL game reports throughout the season.**

SFU Rosters, Team Registration, Guest Play, and Red Card Reporting Procedures:

The procedures for player registration and the completion of SFU Game Rosters and SFU Team Registration Forms can be complicated. Please make sure you are completely aware of all rules regarding the registration and rostering of players. Teams are still required to register their players to a "SFU Primary" team and to notify the registrar of those changes at least 24 hours prior that player participating in any league games. Player Registration is in two parts. First, players are registered to their club through FYSA. Once registered with FYSA, they are then "SFU Registered" using the new **ONLINE** SFU Team Registration Form. Only Club Reps and their designees are able to enter the players into the new online registration form. For a non-club rep to use the form, they must obtain the link and passcode for their respective team and register online. Once completed, a backup copy of the form can be printed. Printing the form requires adobe acrobat reader as well as enabling a pop-up web page. Screen prints of the process are included to familiarize you with the process.

Players must be FYSA registered to their club and appear one ONE and ONLY ONE Team Registration Form, 24 hours prior to that player(s) participating in any league games. This requirement is for both new team/player registrations and **any** player additions or movements (i.e. Change of Status). Failure to follow this requirement could lead to game forfeitures, suspensions and sanctions for playing ineligible players. It is no longer necessary to fax team registration forms to the registrar or Secretary as they are able to print the forms directly from the web.

PLAYERS MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN SFUYSA GAMES WITH FYSA TEMPORARY PASSES!

SFUYSA only allows permanent passes for use within the league. Unverified, or "temporary" FYSA passes are not allowed in league games. Do not ask for special permission because it will not be granted unless FYSA has issued a written request asking the league to do so.

The use of "Guest" players during the season is allowed in South Florida United games. Teams may have age-appropriate guest players during the seasonal year, but NO GUEST PLAY will be allowed in any playoffs. Coaches may use any age appropriate players in their games as a means of promoting player development. However; there are several important restrictions that **MUST** be followed.

- 1) The maximum number of guest players allowed per team, per game is five (5) for 11v11, three (3) for 8 v 8 and two (2) for 6 v 6.
- 2) No player may play on more than one SFUYSA team on the same day.
- 3) Guest players are players not on the SFUYSA Team Registration Form for the team they wish to guest play for. They **MUST** however, be on a SFUYSA Team Registration form (SFU-registered) whose code must appear on the game roster under the guest play column. Primary SFU-registration will be determined solely using the SFU Team Registration Form submitted at the appropriate Roster Freeze Date for the event and not by the pass carried by the player.
- 4) Guest players may only come from within your club.
- 5) Guest players may not play on a Division II team within their same age group if they are primarily SFU-registered to a Division I team in that age group.
- 6) Players primarily SFU-registered to a team in their own age group, may guest play up to a team in a higher age group.
- 7) Players that are SFU-registered to a team above their own age appropriate group, **MAY NOT** guest play down to a SFU team registered at a lower age group.
- 8) Guest players **MUST** appear as guest players on the game roster.

As with using players not registered to your team, playing inappropriate guest players carries the same types of sanctions as would be found in playing an illegal player. Be **VERY** careful in your use of guest players!

Red Card reporting and the retention of player passes is the same as in recent seasons. Be aware of the potential fines and suspensions for failing to properly file, prepare and document your reports.

If a red card is issued in a game, or if a coach or spectator is ejected, **BOTH** Coaches, and the referee are required to fax game rosters to the VP Rules and red card committee (305)704-3811. **IT DOES NOT MATTER IF YOUR TEAM DID NOT RECEIVE THE RED CARD OR SUFFER THE EJECTION. BOTH TEAMS MUST SEND IN BOTH COPIES OF THE GAME REPORTS.** Referees are also required to file supplementary reports. Failing to send in a game report within the 48 hour reporting period results in the following fines:

Failing to File Red Card Reports

\$50 failing to file a game report where a red card was issued to **opponents team** (1st offense)

\$100 second offense

\$200 three or more offenses plus a 3 game suspension

\$100 failing to file a game report where a red card was issued to their **own team** (1st offense)

\$200 second offense

\$500 three or more offenses plus a 6 game suspension

\$25 for any referee that fails to file game report (charged to the club) plus suspension of referee until supplemental report is properly filed.

Failing to File Game Report for Service of Red Card

\$25 for failing to file game report seeking red card service within 48 hours. Alternatively, no credit for service.

Any questions regarding the red card procedure should be directed to the VP Rules. Do NOT fax all game rosters to the VP Rules. The only rosters that are required to be faxed are those in which a player (on either team) received a red card or to get credit for one serving it.

Miscellaneous

\$25 for unlisted administrative violation

Suspension Service Requirements:

For **SFUUSA** games in which suspended players or coaches are serving their suspension:

- 1) **PRIOR** to giving the game roster to the referee, check the "OUT" box next to the players' name and draw a thin line through the players name. Ensure that the players name is legible. Write "Out Serving Red Card" in the open area to the right of the players' name. Reporting the service for Coaches should be similarly identified.
- 2) When presenting the roster to the referee **BEFORE** the game, ask the referee to initial next to the "Out Serving Red Card" statement that the player is out.
- 3) **PLAYERS SERVING A SUSPENSION MUST BE ONE OF THE 18 PLAYERS ON THE GAME ROSTER.** Rosters may NOT be modified to add additional lines. Similarly, coaches serving a suspension must also be identified in one on the three coaches' spots on the roster.
- 4) Players are NOT required to be at the game in which they are serving a suspension, but may attend.
- 5) Coaches are NOT PERMITTED to be at a game in which they are serving a suspension. This means they cannot be within "sight or sound" of the game. They also may NOT communicate remotely via electronic or other means with their teams while serving a suspension.
- 6) Fax a copy of the rosters to the Red Card Committee (305)704-3811 or email a scanned copy to redcards@sfuusa.com to prove the player sat out.

For **Non-SFUUSA** games in which suspended players or coaches are serving their suspension:

- 1) The **ONLY** acceptable proof of service is the *SFUUSA Suspension Service Reporting Form* (<http://www.dataleague.com/sfu/suspensionserviceform.pdf>)

The *SFUUSA Suspension Service Reporting Form* is for reporting SFUUSA suspension service outside of league play only. Service within league games must be reported on league game rosters ONLY. All games MUST be served in FULL SIDED MATCHES ONLY (11v11, U11-12, 8v8, U9-10 6v6). To be accepted. Suspension service acceptance is at the discretion of the VP of Rules, and must be served with Primary team, or under special circumstance as Pre-approved by VP of Rules, SFUUSA.

SFUUSA Game Roster Formats:

SFUUSA Game Rosters changed in 2004-2005, and have been slightly amended for the 2008-2009 season. The new game roster form is on the web site and is also included in this coaches manual. The only change this year is the addition of the ability to use the team registration form as a basis to complete and print the form online. Those of you with access to the online registration will be able to pre-fill the form from the players listed in your registration. Once you choose to print the form, it will open in adobe acrobat and you can add guest players, a game number, etc. Pick up some NCR paper and you can have perfectly legible game rosters with a minimum of time and effort. ALL GAME ROSTERS **MUST** be provided on 3 part NCR paper, or other methodology for 3 copies to be provided. All information **MUST** be typed and clearly legible. In situations where guest players are added to the normal roster, it is acceptable for those players to be handwritten into the form as long as the information is clearly legible on ALL copies. If a player's name cannot be determined due to handwriting legibility, the player will have been assumed to be NOT on the roster. If he participated, the game is subject to forfeiture. Coaches are responsible for ensuring all information is complete and accurate. All game rosters must be kept until the end of the season (April 2009). Failure to follow the procedures for proper completion and submission of Game and/or Team Registration forms may result in game forfeitures, coach suspensions and administrative fines.

TEAMS are REQUIRED to use SFUUSA GAME ROSTER FORMS.

Field Marshals:

Field marshals are required at all SFUUSA games. Their role is to provide a calming influence on the spectators and hopefully act as a deterrent toward conduct that falls below the standards as established by FUSA and SFU. They are there to assist the referee in dealing with or

disciplining spectators that the referee(s) feel are worthy of such attention and action. Each home club MUST provide a field marshal at each of their games. This person SHOULD NOT be affiliated with the team that is currently playing the game they are marshalling. They are not there to cheer for the home team and should be viewed as unbiased observers. and should wear a bright vest to easily identify their position and role. The field marshal needs to be identified to the referee PRIOR to the game and put their name on the game roster. Failing to provide a field marshal at a home game is an administrative violation that carries a fine plus the potential for removal of home games, for persistent violators.

Under 9/10, and Under 11/12 Field and Rule Modifications:

SFUYSA will be utilizing the US Youth Soccer Association recommended field size and player participation format in its games. Modifications to FIFA Rules are listed below for these two categories.

U9-U12 Restriction on Punts and Free Kicks in Small-sided Games:

In all small sided games U9 through U12; an indirect free kick from the center mark will be awarded to the opponent when a goal keeper punts, or a player kicks a free kick from one penalty area to

the other penalty area without the ball being played first by another player.

U9/10

Law 1 – The Field of Play

Dimensions: The field of play must be rectangular. The length of the touchline must be greater than the length of the goal line.

Length: minimum 45 yards maximum 60 yards

Width: minimum 35 yards maximum 45 yards

Field Markings: Distinctive lines not more than (5) inches wide. The field of play is divided into two halves by a halfway line. The center mark is indicated at the midpoint of the halfway line. A circle with a radius of eight (8) yards is marked around it.

The Goal area: Conform to FIFA (6 yds).

The Penalty Area: A penalty area is defined at each end of the field as follows: Two lines are drawn at right angles to the goal line, fourteen (14) yards from the inside of each goalpost. These lines extend into the field of play for a distance of fourteen (14) yards and are joined by a line drawn parallel with the goal line. The area bounded by these lines and the goal line is the penalty area. Within each penalty area a penalty mark is made ten (10) yards from the midpoint between the goalposts and equidistant to them. An arc of a circle with a radius of eight (8) yards from each penalty mark is drawn outside the penalty area.

Goals: 6 x 18 or 7 x 21

Law 2 – The Ball: Size four (4).

Law 3 – The Number of Players: A match is played by two teams, each consisting of not more than six players, one of whom is the goalkeeper. The minimum number of players including the goal keeper required to continue or start play is four (4). The maximum number of guest players allowed in a game is two (2).

Law 7 – The Duration of the Match: Conform to FIFA with the exception of the match being divided into two (2) halves of twenty-five (25) minutes each. There shall be a half-time interval of five (5) minutes.

Law 8 – The Start and Restart of Play: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents of the team taking the kick-off are at least eight (8) yards from the ball until it is in play.

Law 13 – Free Kicks: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents are at least eight (8) yards from the ball.

Law 14 – The Penalty Kick: Conform to FIFA with the exceptions that the penalty mark is at ten yards and that players other than the kicker and defending goalkeeper are at least eight (8) yards from the penalty mark.

Law 17 – The Corner Kick: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents remain at least eight (8) yards away from the ball until it is in play.

U11/12

Law 1 – The Field of Play

Dimensions: The field of play must be rectangular. The length of the touchline must be greater than the length of the goal line.

Length: minimum 60 yards maximum 80 yards

Width: minimum 45 yards maximum 55 yards

Field Markings: Distinctive lines not more than (5) inches wide. The field of play is divided into two halves by a halfway line. The center mark is indicated at the midpoint of the halfway line. A circle with a radius of eight (8)

yards is marked around it.

The Goal area: Conform to FIFA (6 yds).

The Penalty Area: A penalty area is defined at each end of the field as follows: Two lines are drawn at right angles to the goal line, fourteen (14) yards from the inside of each goalpost. These lines extend into the field of play for a distance of fourteen (14) yards and are joined by a line drawn parallel with the goal line. The area bounded by these lines and the goal line is the penalty area. Within each penalty area a penalty mark is made ten (10) yards from the midpoint between the goalposts and equidistant to them. An arc of a circle with a radius of eight (8) yards from each penalty mark is drawn outside the penalty area.

Goals: 6 x 18, or 7 x 21

Law 2 – The Ball: Size four (4).

Law 3 – The Number of Players: A match is played by two teams, each consisting of not more than eight players, one of whom is the goalkeeper. The minimum number of players including the goal keeper required to continue or start play is five (5). The maximum number of guest players allowed in a game is three (3).

Law 7 – The Duration of the Match: Conform to FIFA with the exception of the match being divided into two (2) halves of thirty (30) minutes each. There shall be a half-time interval of five (5) minutes.

Law 8 – The Start and Restart of Play: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents of the team taking the kick-off are at least eight (8) yards from the ball until it is in play.

Law 13 – Free Kicks: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents are at least eight (8) yards from the ball.

Law 14 – The Penalty Kick: Conform to FIFA with the exceptions that the penalty mark is at ten yards and that players other than the kicker and defending goalkeeper are at least eight (8) yards from the penalty mark.

Law 17 – The Corner Kick: Conform to FIFA with the exception that opponents remain at least eight (8) yards away from the ball until it is in play.

FYSA Player Hydration Rule:

FYSA has adopted the following rule mandating player hydration breaks during the game.

402.4 Player Hydration

In any FYSA sanctioned match a break will be given at the midpoint of each half of regulation time and at the end of each overtime period (if played) for player hydration. This break will be given at a normal stoppage of play and it is mandatory for any FYSA sanctioned match during which the air temperature is or is expected to reach eighty-five (85) degrees.

Mercy Rule:

After the first half has been completed, or at any point in time in the second half where the goal differential meets or exceeds eight (8) goals, the game is considered complete and the match shall be ended.

Player Jersey Issues and Procedures:

The following is an excerpt from FIFA's advice to referees on player uniforms. Some of the new uniforms worn by teams are not predominately one color and may cause confusion on the part of the referee in his game decisions. As such, you need to be aware that if your team's uniform cannot be distinguished from the other team's by the referee, you may not be allowed to play the game. Should the referee decide that the uniforms are not sufficiently distinguishable, it is the **HOME** Team's responsibility to provide an alternate jersey. Should the referee also decide that the alternate jersey is indistinguishable; the **HOME** team may elect to wear training vests ("Pinnies") as long as players' numbers can be easily determined by the referee. However; if the home team is unable to provide an alternate jersey due to the **VISITORS** jersey not being predominately one color, the **VISITOR** will be required to play in their alternate jersey, or "Pinnies". Should either team wish to protest to the referee that the uniforms are too similar, they may do so, but it is the referee's final decision as to if they will allow the match to be played.

FIFA Advice to Referees

Law 4 — Players' Equipment

4.1 WEARING UNIFORMS

It is implicit in the Law that each side wear a distinctively colored jersey, that shorts and socks be uniform for each team, and that the uniforms be distinguishable from the uniforms worn by the other team. The referee shall ensure that each player wears his uniform and equipment properly. Players' jerseys must remain tucked inside their shorts, socks must remain pulled up, and each player must wear shin guards under the socks. Slide pants or similar undergarments must be the same main color as the shorts. [sic 4.2 & 4.3]

4.4 GOALKEEPER UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT

Under Law 4, goalkeepers must wear a jersey color distinct from the players of both teams. In addition, goalkeepers traditionally wear items of clothing besides those prescribed under Law 4. These items include soft hats or caps, gloves, pants with special hip or thigh pads, jerseys with pads along the elbows and arms, and separate pads for knees or elbows. There is no problem as long as these items of clothing do not present a danger to any players, are of a color distinct from the uniforms of players of either team and are, in the opinion of the referee, clearly related to the goalkeeper's function. The referee should prevent any player other than the goalkeeper from wearing an item of clothing or equipment that is permitted to the goalkeeper under these criteria.

If the two goalkeepers' shirts are the same color and neither has another shirt to change into, the referee shall allow the match to proceed.

End of Season Dates & Championship Playoff Format:

Regular Season ends on February 15th, 2009 for all U11 to U17. All games must be completed by that time in order for consideration of standings toward championship playoffs. In rare circumstances where weather has caused problems in completing a significant number of games, the Divisional VP may allow for games to be postponed or removed from the schedule. Each division will have its own format for determination of playoff participants.

The number of playoff positions for Regular Season will be determined based upon the number of teams participating in the division. For teams participating in divisions with less than 12 teams, there will be 2 to 4 playoff spots depending upon if there was a single complete round robin of games. For teams participating in divisions with less than 17 teams, there will be 4 playoff spots. Those divisions will play a semi-final and final match. In divisions with 17, 18, or 19 teams, there will be 6 playoff spots with byes awarded to the top two teams. The remaining four teams will play a quarterfinal match first and then the winners of the quarterfinals will play the two bye teams in semi-final and final matches. Teams in divisions with 20 or more teams will send the top 8 teams to quarterfinal, semi-final and final matches. The order of finish will be based upon the highest average points.

Ties will be broken using the following procedure. For all tiebreakers, if an uneven number of games have been played, any numerical measurements will be averaged over the number of games.

Tiebreakers

- 1) Head-to-Head
- 2) Goal Differential (with a maximum of +/- 3 per game)
- 3) Most Wins (avg)
- 4) Fewest Losses (avg)
- 5) Fewest goals against (avg)
- 6) Kicks from the Penalty Mark

In cases where there are more than two teams tied, head-to-head will only be applied if all three or more teams have played each other. If so and one team has lost to all of the others, that team is eliminated and the rest of the tiebreakers are applied to the remaining teams.

For the U9 and U10 age groups, the Regular Season will end on February 8th, 2009. In lieu of championship series, all teams will be eligible to participate in a seeded jamboree. All players will receive medals and will play a series of games at the conclusion of the regular season. The Jamboree for 2009 will occur during the weekend of February 14th-15th.

Forms without coaches' information, including licensure, will be treated as incomplete and subject to disqualification. At a minimum, all **BOLD-faced** fields must be completed and the requisite number of players declared.

Recommended maximum player registrations per team are based upon the playing format. For U9 – U10 (6 vs. 6), the maximum number of registered players should be 12. For U11 – U12 (8 vs. 8), the maximum number of registered players should be 16. For U13 and above (11 vs. 11), the maximum number of registered players should be 22.

- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol; and expect everyone to refrain from their use at all soccer games.
- I will do the best I can each day, remembering that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- I will treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times; regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will concentrate on playing soccer. Always giving my best effort.
- I will play by the rules at all times.
- I will at all times control my temper, resisting the temptation of retaliate.
- I will always exercise self control.
- Conduct during competition towards play of the game and all officials shall be in accordance with appropriate behavior and in accordance with FIFA's "Laws of the Game", and in adherence to **FYSA** rules.
- While traveling, shall conduct themselves so as to bring credit to themselves and their team.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Section 1. DEFINITIONS - as defined in the Association's By-Laws (Article VIII - Directors) Listed below are definitions and functions of officers and other criteria found in the South Florida United Youth Soccer Association (SFUYSA) Rules and Regulations.

- A. FIFA - Federation International de Football Association
- B. USSF - United States Soccer Federation
- C. USYSA - United States Youth Soccer Association
- D. FYSA - Florida Youth Soccer Association
- E. SFUYSA - South Florida United Youth Soccer Association
- F. EXECUTIVE BOARD - consists of the following titles and duties:
 - 1. PRESIDENT whose duty is to Chair and maintain order at all SFUYSA meetings.
 - 2. VICE PRESIDENT, DIVISION I herein known as VP Div. I, whose duties are as follows:
The VP Div. I shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to the teams in this division, unless they are of a nature which is under the jurisdiction of the VP Rules. The VP Div. I will establish a playing schedule, maintain and provide current standings at all Association meetings and modify the schedule, when necessary. The VP Div. I will conduct a mandatory coach's meeting at least seven days prior to the commencement of the playing season.
 - 3. VICE PRESIDENT, DIVISION II herein known as VP Div. II, whose duties are as follows:
The VP Div. II shall be responsible for all matters pertaining to the teams in this division, unless they are of a nature which is under the jurisdiction of the VP Rules. The VP Div. II will establish a playing schedule, maintain and provide current standings at all Association meetings and modify the schedule, when necessary. The VP Div. II will conduct a mandatory coach's meeting at least seven days prior to the commencement of the playing season.
 - 4. VICE PRESIDENT, REFEREES herein known as VP Referees, whose duties are to maintain records of all matters pertaining to referees officiating games of this Association and to handle the assignment responsibilities for the playoffs at the end of the early and regular seasons. The VP Referees shall be the link between the club assignors and the Florida State Referee Association (FSR) in regards to referee clinics and assignor clinics. The VP Referees shall be responsible for all SFUYSA matters pertaining to the club assignors. The VP Referees will insure that each club assignor has a current FSR listing of referees.
 - 5. VICE PRESIDENT, RULES AND REGULATIONS herein known as VP Rules, whose duties are as follows: to review all violations of the Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and / or Rules and Regulations of this corporation; establish the playing rules for each playing season with the subsequent ratification of same by the Board of Directors; review of all disciplinary actions and recommend disciplinary measures to be assessed, pursuant to the rules and regulations of FYSA, USYSA, and of this corporation; review all protests and appeals; select Hearing Board members when necessary; and maintain a record of all disciplinary actions, protests and appeals.
This officer shall not be a party to any appeal or protest hearing.
 - 6. SECRETARY whose duties are to record and transcribe the minutes of all SFUYSA meetings and maintain records of Association activities.
 - 7. TREASURER whose duties are to maintain accurate bookkeeping record of fees and fines of all Club members, pay invoices, maintain checking account and handle all accounting procedures, including taxes.
 - 8. REGISTRAR whose duties are to receive and maintain a current copy of the rosters of all teams prior to the start of any given playing season. Furthermore the registrar shall be responsible for receiving and maintaining a copy of all roster changes for any team during the course of any given season.
- G. BOARD OF DIRECTORS - consists of one (1) club representative or their alternate who is a member in good standing with SFUYSA. Furthermore, any club that misses four (4) meetings in a 12-month period shall be subject to affiliation review by the executive board.
- H. CLUB REPRESENTATIVES - herein known as Club Reps, whose duties include:
 - 1. Reporting all game scores to the appropriate VP.
 - 2. Attending all SFUYSA meetings.
 - 3. Being the communication link between the Association and Club.
 - 4. Serve on sub-committees as requested.
 - 5. Liaison between players, parents and coaches to the Association.
 - 6. Being a Voting Delegate (1 vote per Club).
- I. CLUB ASSIGNOR - A currently registered USSF certified assignor, who is hired and paid by the club(s) they are working for, to schedule a three-man referee team to each home game for that club.
- J. HEARING BOARD - A committee of Club Representatives or designees (minimum of three) selected by the VP of Rules and Regulations to hear a protest or an appeal by a club pertaining to a decision made by the aforementioned VP regarding a violation of the Association's; Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Regulations, or specifically published laws of a competition, or the misapplication of the "Laws of the Game".
- K. SCHEDULING COMMITTEE - consisting of VP Div. I, VP Div. II and a Chairperson (ideally the person who will be creating the schedule on a database).
- L. LAWS OF THE GAME - The most current edition of, "FIFA Laws of the Game Guide for Referees United States Soccer Federation"

Section 2 GENERAL RULES OF ORDER

- A. The rules contained herein shall govern members of this Association in all cases to which they are applicable and are in all consistent with the Constitution and By-Laws of this Association. All competition shall be governed by the rules stated herein, unless the rules of a specific competition determine otherwise.
- B. The Association shall adopt and be governed by the applicable rules and regulations of the USSF, USYSA, FYSA, except when more stringent rules and regulations are stipulated by the Association.
- C. All teams participating in boys/men's divisions shall be comprised of a minimum of 80% Boys / Men. Exceptions to this rule must be approved by the Board of Directors. Boys may not participate in designated girl's divisions.
- D. Any SFUYSA affiliated club which resides outside of FYSA Region A, must agree to travel to their home games at the discretion of the visitor if that request is made within the first week of the publication of the schedule. This restriction only applies to Division II teams and below. All Division I and/or Premier teams are expected to travel as per the published schedule.

Section 3 LEVELS OF COMPETITION

- A. DIVISION I shall be comprised of the top competitive traveling teams.
 - 1. Early season age groups: U-19, 18, 17, 16, 15.
 - 2. Regular season age groups: U17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10 & 9.
- B. DIVISION II shall be comprised of the above average competitive travel teams consisting of the regular season age groups: U-17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, & 9.
- C. TEAM PLACEMENT will be the responsibility of the club to place their teams in the appropriate division of play to ensure fair and equitable

competition for SFUYSA affiliated youth soccer teams.

1. The Divisional VP shall have the right to move teams either by age groups or between divisions should their performance indicate improper placement.
2. After the declaration deadline, any withdrawals or additions of teams will incur a \$500 fine. Requests to move between divisions will be considered both a withdrawal and an addition and be subject to a \$1,000 fine. Requests for movement of teams must be in writing and signed by Club Rep. There is no guarantee that requests will be accommodated by the league.
3. Any costs incurred by schedule changes will be the responsibility of those clubs requesting the changes (minimum of \$100 per team).
4. All clubs in the process of becoming a new affiliate shall submit all their teams for placement review by the executive board or its designees. Placement shall be based upon each team's competitive performance in the previous year.
5. A team/player may be allowed to play out of its age group at the discretion of the Board of Directors of SFUYSA.

Section 4 SEASONAL CONCEPT OF SFUYSA

A. The year shall be defined at the Annual General Meeting of the Board of Directors and a Calendar of events shall be published.

B. The playing schedule of SFUYSA shall be:

1. EARLY SEASON shall be comprised of Division I traveling teams in the following age groups: U-19, U-18, U-17, U-16, U-15. The season shall run August to November, or as determined by the Board of Directors. The season shall consist of a minimum 8 game schedule, with a play-off.
2. REGULAR SEASON shall be comprised of traveling teams as defined under Section 3, Levels of Competition. Whenever possible, the age groups will be single age. The season shall begin in November and run to March, or as determined by the Board of Directors. The season shall consist of a minimum 8 game schedule with a 4 team SFUYSA Cup play-off. Other playoff formats as determined by the Competition Committee may also be utilized.
3. U9 and U10 Age Groups will play a season ending jamboree in lieu of a championship playoff and no standings will be published during the year.
4. Other Seasons as approved by the Board of Directors

Section 5 PLAYERS, COACHES AND TEAM REGISTRATION AND TRANSFER

A. Players and coaches participating in SFUYSA sanctioned games must be registered with FYSA according to its organizational requirements.

1. All players and coaches MUST have a **current, laminated** FYSA or USYSA player/coach's pass card, signed by the appropriate District Commissioner, with a **current picture** on the back of the card, prior to competing in any SFUYSA competition.
2. In order to compete in any age group, a player may NOT exceed that age prior to August 1st.
5. A player shall be rostered to only one Primary team at any given time during a season: (e.g. Early or Regular or Late), but may participate as a guest player on any other age appropriate team within the club.
6. When a Club has more than one team participating in any age group, and the teams play in more than one division in said age group, a player who is rostered to a higher division team cannot play for a lower division team unless it is a permanent roster change/move.
7. Transfers or additions or movements of players to a new team (except intra-club) within any season (early, regular or late) will cause the player to be ineligible for further league play UNLESS specifically approved to play by the VP of the Division or the Executive Board.
8. Coaches shall be subjected to the same disciplinary sanctions as players and should expect to incur disciplinary sanctions greater than the players.
9. All Teams shall have at least one (1) FYSA registered Coach from the team's club at the game in order to play.

B. Each club shall submit a list of teams; by age and division, home field; locations and availability, coaches; names, telephone numbers and coaches' license numbers, and the name and telephone number of a USSF certified assignor by the following dates:

1. Early Season: as determined by the Board of Directors of SFUYSA, the SFUYSA Executive Board, or the Competition Committee. (Typically July 1st)
2. Regular Season: as determined by the Board of Directors of SFUYSA, the SFUYSA Executive Board, or the Competition Committee. (Typically September 15th)
3. Other Seasons as may be defined
4. Any outstanding team or club fees or fines must be paid prior to commencement of any competition, except as approved by the Executive Board.

C. Signed and Approved Rosters: Each club must submit a SFUYSA Team Registration signed and approved by the District Commissioner or Club's Registrar, for each team in said club prior to the start of the seasonal year. Within 24 hours of an additional player registering with the club, the league registrar shall receive by email or fax an amended copy of the roster. If a player plays in a league game with less than 24 hours notification to the league registrar, that team shall forfeit the game to its opponent 3-0. (Team Registration will be conducted online as soon as it is available.)

D. Visiting Players & Coaches: Any coach who allows a player registered to another club team to participate in organized practices with their team shall have 48 hours (from first practice) to notify the club representative of the affected club, in writing, of the player's attendance at their practice. Failure to do so shall result in a four game suspension of said coach and may result in a poaching charge. Further violations by the same coach shall result in a disciplinary hearing.

E. POACHING (FYSA 401.6)

Curbing poaching activities will be the sole responsibility of the team's coaches. Any of the team's coaches may be held responsible for the actions of any member of the team including, but not limited to, the players, parents, team staff, club representatives, relatives of players, etc., currently associated with his/her team. Ignorance of the actions of others shall not be deemed a defense for a poaching charge brought against any of the team's coaches.

A. Poaching shall be defined as:

1. The act of attempting to induce or the inducing of a registered and/or rostered player and/or coach to transfer or otherwise leave his/her current team/club prior to the end of the seasonal year (Sept 1-Aug. 31);
2. The transfer to the team for which a player was a guest player within a period of 120 days after the guesting event without the written consent of both coaches;
3. Improper contact with currently registered and/or rostered players; or
4. The violation of guest player procedures.

B. There is to be NO improper contact between the prospective team and the player/parents of currently registered and/or rostered players. Any coach or member of a team having contact with a player after a player is registered and/or rostered, without first obtaining written permission from that player's coach, will be construed as having had improper contact with a player, and such action can result in a charge of poaching.

1. Improper contact is defined as any communication with a player other than the most casual, cordial communication necessary such as congratulations at the end of a match or similar such conversations. This contact specifically includes, but is not limited to, players participating in practices, training sessions, scrimmages or other soccer-related functions.
2. Improper contact shall also include, but is not limited to, meetings with players/parents, attendance at team social functions when the

player is not registered to that team, etc.

3. Any such improper contact, no matter how generated, is prohibited without prior written notification and written consent of the player's current head coach, the club director of coaching and/or players, or the president of the club to which the player is currently registered and/or rostered. A coach/volunteer or member of a team having contact with a player is charged with the knowledge of that player's registration and/or roster status and shall be held accountable for any unauthorized contact with any player currently not rostered to his team, regardless of how that contact is initiated or by whom.
- C. Offering a registered/rostered player a roster position will be considered an inducement and evidence of poaching, unless previous written permission has been granted.
- D. In order to avoid a charge of poaching, the head coach must, in writing, direct any and all inquiries concerning a registered and/or rostered player to the player's current head coach, director of coaching or the club president and receive written permission prior to any and all contact with the player or his/her parents regarding that player's movement and/or participation in a guesting event. In the event a player or his agent (i.e., parents or guardian) contacts a coach, it shall be the responsibility of the contacted coach to notify in writing the player's coach/club and receive written permission prior to any additional contact with the player and/or anyone acting as agent for that player.
- E. For an affiliate to recruit the services of a registered coach, the requesting club must first notify the agent of record as listed on the affiliation form of the coach's current club. (This can be obtained from either the local DC or Regional Vice President.) Currently registered coaches may not contact a prospective club until after State Cup Final 4. Coaches who determine during a seasonal year to change clubs shall not solicit, entice or induce in any manner players they are currently coaching to move to his/her new club until after the completion of State Cup Final 4, or further National Championship Play. Violation of this standard is paramount to poaching.
- F. Procedure for guesting events
In order to invite a player to be a guest player for a tournament, to train with any team to which the player is not currently rostered, to participate in any event with a team to which the player is not currently rostered (i.e., practices, scrimmages, trips, etc.), the head coach desiring the participation of a player must direct a request, in writing, to the player's current head coach (as listed in the Official League Contact publication or FYSA's website); director of coaching, if applicable; or club president. That contact must in turn respond with their approval in writing prior to approaching the player. A guest player may not transfer to the team for which he/she was a guest player for a period of 120 days after the guesting event without the written consent of both coaches. The action of the player participating in any event with any team to which he/she is not rostered without prior written permission shall be sufficient evidence for the imposition of sanctions against the team's head coach.
- G. Disciplinary Sanctions
Minimum disciplinary actions/sanctions to be taken against any coach or member of a team found guilty of the violation of any of the above conditions shall be:
 - 1st Offense -- Six (6) months suspension; club to be fined \$100.00 plus any costs associated with the holding of the hearing including copying charges, postage, etc.
 - 2nd Offense -- Minimum three (3) year suspension; club to be fined \$500.00 plus any costs associated with the holding of the hearing including copying charges, postage, etc.
 - Conviction of a poaching charge by any member of a team will cause the team to which that player/coach is registered to forfeit its privilege to participate in any and all FYSA-sponsored events (i.e., State Cup, President's Cup, Kellogg's Bowl, etc.) for the remainder of the seasonal year. The team sanctioning will apply only to the team that is involved in the poaching incident, not multiple teams if the player/coach or team member is registered to more than one team.
- H. Limitations on tryouts
It shall not be considered poaching to invite any player to try-out for a team to be formed for the next seasonal year so long as no contact is made until after the conclusion of State Cup Finals, or as may be set within a Region of FYSA, and prior to August 1st, unless that player is not currently registered/rostered to any FYSA team. [Players registered to any team competing in National Championship Competition ("NCC") beyond FYSA's State Cup Final Four may NOT be approached in ANY manner until that team is eliminated from NCC.]

F. Roster Freezes to Registrar 30 days prior to playoffs of any playing season.

G. Penalty for any team which disbands after the submission deadlines named in Section 5.b., Player and Team Registration and Transfer, will incur a \$500.00 fine for its club, plus costs of rescheduling, if necessary.

Section 6 SFUYSA FEES

- A. A performance bond shall be required in the amount of \$300.00 per club. From this bond shall come any unpaid fines charged against the club, any unpaid referee's fees due to that club's failure to show for a game, and fees not paid to the Association.
 1. Any fees or fines charged against this bond which are not repaid within 30 days of due notice, will result in the club being placed in bad standing with SFUYSA.
 2. Upon a club's written notice to SFUYSA of its intent to drop out of SFUYSA, the club's performance bond will be returned to the club minus any outstanding fines or fees.
- B. A \$100.00 administrative fee shall be charged to each club per seasonal year.
- C. The Board of Directors shall set the team fee for each season at its July meeting: For 2008-09 a fee of \$100.00 per team / per season shall be imposed.

Section 7 SFUYSA COACHING LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

All coaches in SFUYSA are required to obtain a recognized COACHING LICENSE /DIPLOMA in accordance to the level of team play.

- A. Division I and II Head Coaches are required a minimum "FYSA 'E' LICENSE or equivalent coaching certification.
- B. A new Head Coach, who has never coached in SFUYSA, shall be given 1 year to obtain the required level of licensure.
- C. SFUYSA or its affiliates or in conjunction with its affiliates shall provide FYSA state coach's license courses at least once each calendar year.
- D. All new clubs applying for affiliation must submit, for each team, a separate and individual coach who has attained a minimum of an "E" license or equivalent.

Section 8 REFEREES

- A. Referee Assignors: SFUYSA sanctioned clubs shall be responsible for assigning a three-person currently certified referee team to all scheduled home games.

1. As per Section 5.b., Player and Team Registration and Transfer, each club shall submit the name of their state certified referee assignor (See Sec. 1.G.) to the VP Referees.
 2. If a club fails to submit an assignor, NO games will be scheduled for that club.
 3. Club assignors shall be paid by the club who selected them.
 4. SFUYSA clubs failing to assign three (3) certified referees for any scheduled games, without notification, shall be fined \$10.00 for the first offense and \$20.00 for each additional offense for that playing season.
 5. All assignors shall supply their weekly league contact and assignment sheets to the VP of Referees no later than the Tuesday following the weekend's games.
 6. Only currently certified referees that are on the approved FSR list as distributed by the league shall be used. Any currently certified referee not on the list shall supply the assignor with proof of certification. Prior to assigning said referee the assignor shall supply the VP of Referees with the aforementioned documentation.
 7. Assignors shall endeavor to assign the highest-grade referees available on the list to all early season games.
- B. Referee payment:** Only certified (USSF) referees may be assigned and receive payment for services rendered.
1. Referees who are assigned to a series of games, which have the incorrect game times, shall be paid the fees due for the first game of the series only. The fees will be the responsibility of the home team's club.
 2. Referee fees shall be paid prior to the game, in cash (in correct change), by each team's coach.
 3. Payment shall be a 50-50 split of the full fee by each team.

5. The Board of Directors shall set the referee fees for each seasonal year .
 6. Forfeits (see Sec 9 L 5 & 8.) and Rainouts (see Sec 9 L 6)
- C. Referee Misconduct:** All reports of referee misconduct shall be reported in writing to the VP Referees, within 48 hours of the actions.
1. Referees who are a NO SHOW, coaches will notify Club Rep, who will notify the VP Referees to pursue the appropriate actions.
 2. The VP Referees shall forward such reports of misconduct, if proven valid, to the Florida State Referee Administration office.
 3. Referees who miss three (3) assignments will no longer be assigned games in SFUYSA and the FSR Association shall be notified for further disciplinary action.

Section 9 STANDING RULES OF COMPETITION

- A. Except where modified herein, rules of play shall be FIFA "Laws of the Game". Competition sanctioned by the Association shall abide by the "Laws of the Game" and any modifications specifically published by the FYSA, unless further modified by SFUYSA.
- B. Players under 10 years of age shall play soccer under the auspices of USYSA, FYSA, and SFUYSA in accordance with the rules of the Developmental Player Program modified playing rules for U-10 and U-8.
- C. All contests sanctioned by the Association shall abide by the official rules, and the modifications as published by this Association, unless otherwise amended by the Board of Directors.
- D. **Scheduled Games:**
All scheduled league games must be played. Failure to play a scheduled league game shall result in the team/club, at fault, being fined for the cost of all referee fees including the assignor where applicable and an additional fine of \$ 200.00 per game.
 1. Scheduled games, unplayed due to rain, field conditions as determined by the referee, or other "acts of god", must be reported to the appropriate Division VP not later than noon of the following Tuesday utilizing the same method as reporting of scores.
 2. Any games unplayed due to "acts of god" must be rescheduled, (as per league policies), not later than 7 days after the original scheduled date and reported to the appropriately designated league representative, within the next reporting period utilizing the same method as reporting of scores.
 3. The league reserves the right to assign the date, time, and place for any game not scheduled within the seven (7) days and this shall be binding upon both teams
 4. Game Changes: Game changes are allowed up to 24hrs before scheduled game date
- E. **Behavior:**
Officials, directors, and coaches of both clubs/teams are directly responsible to ensure that teams, coaches, fans and spectators conduct themselves in a proper and respectful manner. FYSA's Code of Ethics shall be in effect at all SFUYSA sponsored events.
- F. **THE FIELD:**
 1. The designated home team shall be responsible for the conditions of the grounds, field marking and equipment.. Makeup games due to these conditions, excluding natural causes, will be rescheduled at the opposing team's field.
 2. Properly anchored gold posts are required. NO ANCHOR, NO PLAY.
 3. A crowd line five (5) feet parallel to the outside touch-line on both sides of the field is recommended.
 4. It will be the responsibility of both teams to have an appropriate game ball. In a mixed age division the ball size shall conform to the age group of the younger of the divisions.
 5. The referee is responsible for determination of the suitability of the field.

 - 3 pts. for win
 - 1 pts. for tie
 - 0 pts. for loss
- H. Champions shall be determined at the direction of the Board of Directors prior to the start of each season.
- I. Awards 1st and 2nd place winning teams will receive trophies.
- J. Player Passes: Should a player participate in a league game with a team to which he is not properly registered (must have team specific player pass with the proper team code on it) or is currently under suspension from said team, the team shall automatically forfeit the contest 3 –0 and the player and coach may be subject to further disciplinary action by the Association.
 1. All players/coaches shall individually present their **laminated** player pass cards to the referee prior to the start of the game. Any player who was not present at the start of the game shall present his pass to the referee or referee’s assistant prior to entering the field of play. If a player/coach does not present a VERIFIED laminated pass to the referee prior to participation, he shall not participate in that game. **NO PASS NO PLAY.**

Player/Coach pass cards are to be returned to the team’s manager or coach at the conclusion of the game. Player /Coach sent off the field of play must be reported by the Referee on the SFUYSA game report form presented at the game by the Coach and USSF Supplemental Report Forms. This report shall be faxed or e-mailed by the referee and coaches of both teams within 48 hours of the game to VP RULES , to the fax no. and/or e-mail address indicated on the SFUYSA approved Game/Roster Form. Failure to submit this report within 48 hrs may invalidate the report, and the offending party may be subject to appropriate sanctions. Player/Coach Misconduct after the Game-pass disposition: The referee shall report the player/coach judged guilty of a violation committed immediately after the game, for which he would have ejected him, should such violation had taken place during the game.
- K.. Player Uniforms and Equipment:
 1. Player Uniforms: All teams must travel in their club's primary colors. Contrasting, where colors of competing teams are identical or similar, the designated home team must change to colors distinct from their opponents’.
 2. Goalkeeper’s uniform: The uniform or jersey of the goalkeeper must be distinctly different from the basic colors of either competing team.
 3. Uniform numbers: Players’ uniform numbers are to be affixed to the back of the uniform shirt; no two players from one team may have an identical uniform number.
 4. Casts and/or braces: Players wearing a permanent orthopedic cast shall not be eligible to participate in any game. Orthopedic braces may be allowed if:
 - a. The player has a written statement at the game from a physician, stating the brace is necessary and that no further injury is likely to occur to the joint that is supported by the brace; **AND**
 - b. The parent has signed a waiver to free FYSA and SFUYSA from any claim against FYSA and SFUYSA or its insurance company in case of further injury to the joint protected by the brace.
 - c. A player may be removed from the game at any time if the referee determines that the player is using or is attempting to use a brace to injure another player.
 5. NO JEWELRY permitted. (Taped earrings are not allowed.)
 6. All players MUST wear protective shin guards (to be worn beneath their game socks) at all times while actively participating in the game. Such shin guards shall be of the type and style of protective athletic equipment specifically designed to protect the player’s lower leg (shin bone). Shin Guards must provide a reasonable degree of protection.
 7. Additional shirts (under the jersey) and long pants (under the shorts and socks) are allowed for players during cold or inclement weather at the discretion of the referee.
 8. All players, including goalkeeper’s, shirts MUST be tucked in.
 9. Slider pants are permissible.
 10. All team players must dress alike.
- L. Pre GAME
 1. A completed, typed, three-part NCR SFUYSA Game Roste shall be presented by each team to the referee prior to the start of the game with the proper referee fee. A copy of each roster with all the game information including referee names shall be retained by both coaches after completion of the match. Failure by a team to submit said roster prior to game start may result in the game being forfeit.
 2. The referee shall verify the identity of each player by his player pass and shall collect the passes of those players who intend to participate. He shall also collect each team’s coach and assistant coach’s FYSA passes (limited to three (3)).
 3. The referee shall check and make certain that each player’s equipment and uniform is proper.
 4. The referee’s judgment with regards to the physical condition of the field and its acceptability for play, and to the actual happenings and occurrences relating to the conduct of the game, and to those judgments inherently granted to the referee by the “Laws of the Game” as published by FIFA shall not be challenged.
 5. A team may have up to a 15 minutes grace period past the scheduled game time. The game shall begin if the minimum number of players (7) are present. Failure to meet this requirement shall be reported by the referee to the home team assignor who in turn shall notify the proper division VP. The final disposition of the game shall be determined by the League. The team that fails to meet this requirement shall be responsible for all costs incurred. The referee shall NOT ask for the fees from the team present.
 6. In cases of rain-outs declared less than 24 hours before the scheduled game start time, where the referee or the parks and recreation personnel calls the game prior to its start, a \$5.00 travel fee will be paid to each of the referees.
 7. A game completed to half time shall be considered a complete game if per chance the game has to be stopped, at no fault of either team.
 8. A game not completed to half-time shall be replayed providing neither team is at fault. Should play be abandoned at any time due to one or both of the teams being adjudged at fault, then the defaulting team(s) shall forfeit the game 3-0.
- M. GAME
 1. Substitutions: Players may be substituted only during stoppage of the game. The number of substitutions shall be unlimited. Substitutions may be made at the following times:
 - a. Prior to a throw-in your favor.
 - b. Prior to a goal kick, by either team, or after a goal is scored.
 - c. After an injury, by either team, when the referee has stopped play.
 - d. Between periods.
 - e. The referee MUST be notified each time the goal keeper is changed.
 - f. No substitutions on corner kicks are permitted.
 - g. While the league cannot mandate player substitution after a player receives a caution, it strongly recommends that all coaches substitute the player for a cooling down period. Substitutions are allowable at stoppages of play and it is suggested that the coach discuss this matter prior

- to the start of the game with the referee.
2. A substitute may not enter the field of play until he has been so instructed by the referee.
 3. Small-Sided Game Modifications:
 - a. In all small sided games (U9-U12), an indirect free kick from the center mark will be awarded to the opponent when a goal keeper punts, or a player kicks a free kick from one penalty area to the other penalty area without the ball being played first by another player.
 4. Mercy Rule: After the first half has been completed, or at any point in time in the second half where the goal differential meets or exceeds eight (8) goals, the game is considered complete and the match shall be ended.
- N. Coach, Player, and Spectator requirements during game.
1. Coaching from the sideline: The purpose of which is to provide direction to one's own team on positioning and points of strategy only, is conditionally permitted.
 2. Bench area: Coaches and players must remain on the bench or within the immediate vicinity of the team's bench (10 yards) while the game is in progress. The use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages or any other illegal substances is forbidden before, during or after the game.
 3. Mechanical devices: Coaches, players, and spectators may not utilize mechanical devices, such as voice amplifiers.
 4. Unsporting conduct: Coaches, players and spectators shall not use profanity or make insulting or otherwise derogatory remarks or gestures to their own team, the opposing team, the referee, or to other spectators.
 5. Enticing ill - behavior: Coaches, players, or spectators shall not, by their remarks, gestures, or actions, entice disruptive behavior.
 6. Punitive action: Coaches and players violating the above rules will be subject to ejection, as well as to further disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of this Association. Coaches are responsible for their players and spectators before, during, and after the game and may be subject to disciplinary action determined by the VP Rules.
 7. Each club shall appoint a Association representative (Field Marshal) to be present at every home game sanctioned by the Association. He/she shall be responsible for keeping order on the sidelines and reporting any problems to the Board. The Field Marshal must greet the referee and sign the roster to be credited with compliance.
 8. The Association shall impose greater penalties on players, coaches, and clubs that have recurrent offenses of the Association rules.
- O. Disciplinary Actions
1. SFUYSA will follow the FYSA guidelines for disciplinary actions and sanctions for players, coaches, and spectators. (See attached from FYSA Official Administrative Rulebook: Code of Ethics & Disciplines and Sanctions)
Discipline-Game Conduct per FYSA 502
 - 502.1 When Discipline/Sanctions are imposed, they must meet the required minimums. The Disciplining body must evaluate the incident as to intent, severity, and past misconduct to determine the appropriate disciplines/sanctions. **More severe disciplines/sanctions shall be imposed for multiple RED CARDS during a season and for misconduct directed towards officials or administrators.**
 - 502.2 **ONE GAME SUSPENSION**- Resulting from a second caution ; (i.e. persistent infringement or dissent by word or action) ; misconduct is neither violent or with intent to harm or injure ; *denies the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball (this does not apply to a goalkeeper within his own penalty area), foul / abusive language not directed.*
 - 502.3 **ONE GAME SUSPENSION**- Serious Foul Play is defined as using disproportionate and unnecessary strength in a manner likely to hurt or injure an opponent ; *any tackle from behind which endangers the safety of an opponent* ; and all gestures with any part of the body which implies visual profanity ; any exposure of the anatomy considered lewd and lascivious ; attempting to strike , hit , or punch ; foul/abusive language (in any language) which is directed other than to an official.
 - 502.4 **THREE GAME SUSPENSION** – Foul and/ or abusive language directed toward a referee, assistant , administrator , or game and/or tournament official.
 - 502.5 **FOUR GAME SUSPENSION** – VIOLENT CONDUCT is defined as the aggression of a player towards an opponent with clearly no intent to play or fight for the ball ; threatening gestures ; fighting ; hitting , or punching , spitting .
 - 502.6 **SIX GAME SUSPENSION** – Entering a fight in progress or action resulting in law enforcement being called.
 - 502.7 **ANY PLAYER OR COACH** who receives a second **RED CARD/EJECTION** during a seasonal year or a third within two seasonal years for either **VIOLENT CONDUCT , FOUL/ABUSIVE LANGUAGE OR REFEREE ABUSE**, will be immediately suspended for the remainder of the seasonal year. The player/coach may petition to the Regional Vice President in writing for reinstatement . The Regional Vice President will rule on the petition. The fee for this will be \$100.00
 2. Document Falsification:
(See attached from FYSA Official Administrative Rulebook, Section 402 & 403 Disciplines, & Sanctions)
 3. Red card suspensions can only be served in games played by the respective team.
Coaches must fax or email a copy of both teams SFUYSA Game Rosters to the Red Card Committee whenever an ejection occurs in a match to either team.

Section 10 PROTEST AND APPEALS

These rules shall apply to all individuals, clubs, players, coaches, officials, and administrators of any Club. Protest and appeals shall be as set forth in these rules and in such policies as may be established by the Protest and Appeals Committee, as approved by the Board of Directors and be in keeping with the policies of USYSA, USSF & FYSA. Objectives for SFUYSA establishing these guidelines are to provide for equitable, timely and uniformly applied procedures for reviewing the conduct of its Clubs, supporting their rights, insuring adherence to the rules and applying discipline based on a system of protest and appeal. Uniform rules have been established (See Sec. 9.J.) and consistently applied to insure that the Clubs have every opportunity to file protest/appeal decisions that affect their participation in soccer. Compliance with SFUYSA Rules and By-Laws is required when a Club constructs their own guideline for protest and appeal procedure. They must assure the right to a fair, impartial, and timely hearing protest and appeal process. Entry levels for protesting any discipline or sanction shall be herein defined and ability to appeal the action of the entry-level body can only be based on the failure at the entry level of not having followed proper procedure.

A. DEFINITIONS

1. Protest is defined as a formal method to question and request reversal of a decision or ruling, or lack of a decision or ruling, made by an authority within SFUYSA, which the protesting party believes is contrary to the By-Laws, or Rules, of FIFA, USSF, USYSA, FYSA, or SFUYSA. Any individual, club, officer, or administrator, whose interest is affected by the ruling or decision being protested, may file it.
2. Appeal is defined as a formal method of requesting a reversal of any decision or ruling made by an authority within SFUYSA. It may be filed by any individual, club, or administration, who has been directly affected by that ruling which person affected believes is contrary to the By-Laws or Rules of FIFA, USSF, USYSA, FYSA, or SFUYSA. The person against who a decision has been made must file appeals.
3. Informal hearings is defined as a process with less notification procedures and less strict procedural rules which can be held in cases involving minor infractions.. Notifications may be done by telephone or in person and conduct of the hearing shall be informal so long as the interested parties are notified and have the opportunity to present evidence before a decision is made.

4. Formal hearings are defined as any other hearing, which must be held. The procedures for holding a formal hearing are set forth elsewhere in these rules.
5. Due process shall be defined as the procedures contained within this section and shall guarantee any individual, club, player, coach, official, or administrator of SFUYSA, the right to exercise these procedures. Due process includes the right to know that charges have been made against a person and the right to a hearing before the imposition of any sanctions whatsoever, including suspension, for any period. Exceptions to the hearing requirement are:
 - a. Assault on referee for which a suspension may be imposed immediately until a hearing can be held.
 - b. Arrest or charges for any felony or any other crime involving moral turpitude for which a suspension may be imposed until resolution of all criminal charges.
 - c. Minimum sanctions for red cards are not subject to appeal.

B. PROTEST

Filing protest guarantees a Club or its members the right to a hearing. They must follow the entry level described, beginning at the lowest appropriate level. No level can be skipped if the Club wishes to continue the protest process.

1. Entry levels for filing protest: (In all levels, the individual shall follow the procedures below)
 - a. Team/Individual to the Club.
 - b. Team/Club to SFUYSA, if applicable.
 - c. Team/Club/Association to the appropriate District Commissioner.
 - d. Beyond the level of the District Commissioner, any protest shall be treated as an appeal of the decision or lack of decision of the District Commissioner and shall follow the procedures for appeal beyond the District Commissioner as defined under FYSA.
2. Procedures for filing protest are:
 - a. Entry level of protest as listed above must be followed.
 - b. Basis for the protest must be clear, specifically described and includes all pertinent information.
 - c. Violated rules must be specifically referenced in writing.
 - d. Persons involved must be identified along with their addresses and phone numbers, including those with information but who may not be directly involved.
 - e. Documentation shall be submitted including, signed and certified statements, game reports rosters, and/or other pertinent information.
 - f. Fees as set by SFUYSA, shall be attached. A fee of \$100.00 refundable if the protest is upheld must be included.
 - g. The time requirements for filing protest must be within seven (7) days of the occurrence and in writing.
 - h. The Protest and Appeals Committee may prescribe standard forms for use in filing all protest and appeals within the Association.
3. Failure to meet requirements for filing protest, the reviewing authority may:
 - a. Refuse to hear protest and return it to the person(s) filing protest.
 - b. Return protest to the appropriate entry level for review and reconsideration.
 - c. Deny protest as not having been correctly filed and/or submitted.
4. Tracking a Protest

a. Individual/team to club	7 days
Club to protesting party	10 days
b. Team/Club to Association	7 days
Association back to team/club	10 days
c. Association to District Commissioner	7 days
Back to Association	10 days
d. Beyond the level of District Commissioner, as defined under FYSA Rules.	

C. APPEALS

Filing an appeal guarantees any Club or its members the right to appeal any decision impacting their ability to participate in soccer or deemed to be contrary to SFUYSA Rules or the rules of the Club organization. Appeals to the entry level of the protest are also guaranteed.

1. Preliminary appeal:

If requested by the club with the submittal of proper notice of appeal and with the required fee, the appealing party may request immediate consideration of the ruling to the executive board of SFUYSA. The VP of Rules would then contact a minimum of three with a maximum of five members of the executive board by phone or fax for a verbal ruling. If the ruling is upheld, then the appealing party shall still be entitled to a hearing as per the rules. If the ruling is reversed or modified the appealing party may act as it deems fit. The VP of Rules shall chair the conference but would not have a vote.
2. Levels of appeals are:
 - a. To the District Commissioner, of a decision on Club/Association level.
 - b. Above the District Commissioner level as defined under FYSA Rules.
3. Procedures for filing an appeal are:
 - a. Level of appeal as listed before, has been followed.
 - b. Documentation of all pertinent information is submitted, in writing, including the original decision of the lower authority.
 - c. Time requirements are met following the protest decision.
 - d. Fees, as set by SFUYSA, shall be attached. A \$100.00 refundable fee, if the appeal is upheld, must accompany the filing.
4. Criteria for filing an Appeal are:
 - a. Basis for the appeal is clear evidence that the lower authority failed to follow established procedures during the original review.
 - b. Excessive disciplines and/or sanctions were imposed by the lower authority and are customarily required for the offense.
 - c. Authority not within the Rules of SFUYSA for the alleged offense.
 - d. The lower level authority did not meet time requirements.
5. Denial of an appeal shall be based on:
 - a. Basis of the appeal is not the failure of the lower level of authority to meet the rules.
 - b. Club filing protest is not the person(s) or body that originally filed the protest.
 - c. "Not in Good Standing" is status of the person(s) filing the appeal.
 - d. Different basis or intent, in part or wholly, of the original protest.
 - e. Established rules have not been followed.
6. Tracking of an appeal, (These are guidelines and reasonable variations for legitimate reasons will not invalidate the protest.)

a. Individual/Team to club	7 days
Club to appealing party	10 days
b. Club to Association, if applicable	7 days

- c. Beyond Association as defined under FYSA Rules
- D. DISCIPLINE
 - 1. Requests for disciplinary action submitted to the Association against a member or coach, player, spectator, parent, can be initiated in one of two ways.
 - a. Written referee report filed by the SFUYSA VP Rules.
 - b. Written request from a SFUYSA member to the VP Rules.
 - 1. The submission of a written referee report will automatically result in a conference among the VP Rules, VP Referees, and the referee filing the report as outlined.
 - 2. Based on the conference and in accordance with the rules, the VP Rules will issue a decision to the representative of the club involved within 24 hours of the decision. Disciplinary action involving suspension requires the VP Rules to hold the player/coach pass for the duration of the suspension. Decisions in these matters may be appealed to the Board.
 - 3. Hearing Boards: By the July SFUYSA meeting, each member club must submit the name, address, and phone number of two people from that club who have agreed to be available to sit on a hearing board. Failure to provide a hearing board member when requested is subject to a fine as determined by the Board of Directors.
- E. RED CARDS (EJECTIONS/SEND-OFFS)
 - 1. The league shall publish a list of all red cards. In conjunction with this, the league shall seek to obtain additional information on red cards issued by other affiliates and tournaments.
 - 2. Two red cards, during the league year, for the same offense, ie. Serious foul play or violent conduct issued to a player may subject that player to a doubling of the minimum guidelines. This may also apply if a player receives said red cards while playing in an affiliated league or tournament.
 - 3. A coach who receives a red card shall be subject to automatic suspension for a minimum of two games. The executive board shall further review all incidents and determine whether to convene a hearing board for an additional term of suspension.
 - 4. Teams that receive an accumulation of four red cards for foul and abusive language and or violent conduct during the year shall be subject to a twenty-five dollar fine. Each additional red card for the above offenses shall result in an additional fine of twenty-five dollars.

Section 11. SEASON SCORING AND PLAY OFF RULES

- A. The results of all games must be reported to the divisional VP by 5:00 PM on Tuesday after the game was played via on-line entry. If the score is not appropriately reported in, the game may be recorded as a loss regardless of the outcome of the game.
- B. Each club is responsible for assigning one person to report scores to the divisional VP, instead of each coach calling in their scores.
- C. All makeup games MUST be completed one (1) week prior to playoffs except with the approval of the Division VP, which may waive the one-week requirement due to extenuating circumstances. Failure to comply will result in losses for both teams.
- D. Playoffs where applicable shall be held in each age group to determine a Champion.. The winning team and runner up will each receive an award and each player shall receive an award.
- E. Tie breaker for determining divisional standings will be as follows:
 - 1) Head-to-Head
 - 2) Goal Differential (with a maximum of +/- 3 per game)
 - 3) Most Wins (avg)
 - 4) Fewest Losses (avg)
 - 5) Fewest goals against (avg)
 - 6) Kicks from the Penalty Mark
- F. Play off format and positional rounds will be:
 - 1) The number of playoff positions for Regular Season will be determined based upon the number of teams participating in the division. For teams participating in divisions with less than 12 teams, there will be 2 to 4 playoff spots depending upon if there was a single complete round robin of games. For teams participating in divisions with less than 17 teams, there will be 4 playoff spots. Those divisions will play a semi-final and final match. In divisions with 17, 18, or 19 teams, there will be 6 playoff spots with byes awarded to the top two teams. The remaining four teams will play a quarterfinal match first and then the winners of the quarterfinals will play the two bye teams in semi-final and final matches. Teams in divisions with 20 or more teams will send the top 8 teams to quarterfinal, semi-final and final matches. The order of finish will be based upon the highest average points.
 - 2) Other playoff formats may be designated by the Competition Committee or Divisional VP's.

ARTICLE I - ORGANIZATION

- 1) The corporation's name is the South Florida United Youth Soccer Association, Inc.
- 2) The corporation's seal shall be in the following form:

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

The following are the purposes for which this organization has been organized:

- 1) To encourage the interest of children in soccer by the establishment and existence of youth soccer programs;
- 2) To aid in the development of the physical and mental well being of the children of the communities;
- 3) To provide supervised activities and encourage participation in a program designed to teach good sportsmanship and encourage physical fitness by means of an organized team sport; and
- 4) The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Notwithstanding any other provisions hereinafter set forth, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax pursuant to §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in this corporation shall be by affiliated club. Each member organization of the corporation shall be represented on the Board of Directors by their designated representative. Admission to membership in the corporation shall be restricted to bona fide city programs and independent soccer clubs/associations that are affiliated with Florida Youth Soccer Association (FYSA) and/or US Club Soccer who:

1. Comply with all requirements of the corporation and complete the application form.
2. Apply for membership no later than the March meeting and is approved by the Board of Directors no later than the June meeting for participation in the early and/or regular seasons.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth in paragraph 2 of this section, the Board of Directors or the Executive Committee for the Board of Directors may, in extraordinary circumstances, schedule a Special Meeting or defer to a later meeting, consideration of an application for membership in this corporation.
4. The Board of Directors meeting for consideration of a prospective member's application for membership shall require the presence of a quorum. In order for a prospective member's application for membership to be approved a 75% majority vote of the directors present and voting shall be required.
5. Additional membership requirements are:
 - a. All soccer clubs applying for admission to this corporation must be members in good standing with FYSA and/or US Club Soccer. Conditional acceptance may be granted to clubs whose application to FYSA and/or US Club Soccer has not been acted upon as of the date of application to this corporation. In such cases the applicant must present written evidence signed by the district commissioner that the application for membership in FYSA has been submitted, or an official of US Club Soccer that an application for membership in US Club Soccer has been submitted.
 - b. New members will not be accepted who are indebted to the corporation for outstanding fees arising from membership during prior seasons.
6. There are two classes of membership in the corporation, voting members and non-voting members:
 - a. Voting members:
 - i. Must have at least one active team playing in SFUYSA
 - ii. Will pay the annual affiliation fee set by the voting membership
 - iii. Must attend all regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors
 - iv. Will pay a fine for not attending a regular or special meeting
 - v. Will be allowed to discuss and vote on any matter coming before the Board of Directors
 - b. Non-voting members:
 - i. Will pay the annual affiliation fee set by the voting membership
 - ii. May attend all regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors
 - iii. Will not be fined for not attending a meeting
 - iv. May discuss (but not vote on) any matter coming before the Board of Directors
 - c. At the beginning of each seasonal year, each member in the corporation will declare whether it wishes to be a voting or a non-voting member. Except as noted in paragraph d. iii. below, once that selection has been made, it is binding on the member for the remainder of the seasonal year.
 - d. Voting members who do not attend a regular or special meetings of the Board of Directors will be dealt with as follows:
 - i. For missing a number of meetings (the number decided annually by the Board of Directors) within a seasonal year, will pay the fine set by the Board
 - ii. For missing additional meetings, will pay increasing fines

- iii. At some predetermined number of missed meetings, may be changed, involuntarily, to non-voting member status
- e. Only voting members will be considered when determining whether a quorum is present.

The Board of Directors shall adopt rules, procedures and fee structure required for affiliation to the corporation.

All members shall abide by the corporation's Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, and Rules and Regulations. All members shall also abide by all applicable rules and regulations as promulgated by Florida Youth Soccer Association and/or US Club Soccer.

ARTICLE IV – PROXY VOTING AND QUORUMS

1. A voting member is present at any in-person meeting of the corporation if represented either in person (by the member's Representative or Alternate) or by proxy.
2. Quorums are calculated based upon voting members present either in person or by proxy.
3. Any matter may be voted on by voting members that are present either in person or by proxy.
4. During a single seasonal year a member may be represented by proxy at no more than two (2) meetings.
5. The notice that a member is being represented by proxy may be made either by an e-mail message sent to both the Secretary and the Vice-President - Rules of the corporation, prior to the meeting in question, or by written notification on the form provided by the corporation.
6. At all meetings of the corporation, a quorum consists of 40% of the currently affiliated voting members, plus 1.

ARTICLE V - ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The annual general meeting of this corporation shall be held on or about the second Tuesday of May of each and every year. The Secretary shall cause to be mailed or electronically transmitted to every member in good standing at their address as it appears in the membership records of this corporation a notice stating the date, time and place of such annual meeting.

Each voting member will be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at the annual general meeting. Such votes may be cast in person or by proxy.

At the annual general meeting, except for the election of officers, all votes cast shall be by voice. In an election of officers, ballots shall be provided and there shall not appear any place on such ballot any mark or marking that might tend to indicate the person who cast such ballot.

Whenever a vote shall be by ballot, the Chairperson of the meeting shall immediately prior to the commencement of the balloting, appoint a committee of three (3) who shall act as "Inspectors of Election" and who shall, at the conclusion of such balloting certify in writing to the Chairperson the results and the certified copy shall be physically affixed in the minute book to the minutes of that meeting. No Inspector of Election will be a candidate for office or shall be personally interested in the Question voted upon.

All business shall be conducted pursuant to Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

All corporate powers, business and affairs of this organization shall be managed and directed under the authority of the Board of Directors. Said Board of Directors shall consist of not less than 3 voting members. All of the directors and officers of this organization shall be residents of the State of Florida.

Directors of this corporation shall not be compensated.

A director of this corporation who is present at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which action on any corporate matter is taken will be presumed to have assented to the action taken unless he/she votes against such action or abstains from voting in respect thereto because of an asserted conflict of interest.

The Board of Directors shall consist of one voting representative from each voting member organization which is in good standing; said representative shall be designated at the annual meeting of the membership. At each annual meeting, each voting member organization shall designate its voting representative to hold office until the next annual meeting. A director will hold office until that director's successor has been designated, or that director's prior resignation, removal from office or death.

The Board of Directors shall have the control and management of the affairs and business of this corporation. Such Board of Directors shall only act in the name of the corporation when it is regularly convened by its Chairperson after due notice to all the directors of such meeting. A quorum shall be 40% + 1 of the voting members of the Board of Directors present in person or by proxy. In order for a motion, question or resolution put to a vote before the Board of Directors to be approved, a 50% + 1 majority vote of the directors present and voting shall be required. The Board of Directors may make such rules and regulations covering its meetings as it may in its discretion determine to be necessary.

A resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, may designate an executive committee and/or other committee(s) which will have and may exercise all of the authority of the Board of Directors to the extent provided in such resolution, except as is provided by law.

Special and regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at the principal place of business of the corporation or at such other place as is designated by the Board of Directors.

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors will be held without notice on the second Tuesday of each month. Written

notice of the time and place of special meetings of the Board of Directors will be given to each director by personal delivery, FAX, telegram or electronically transmitted at least two days before the meeting or by notice mailed to the director at least ten days before the meeting.

Notice of a meeting of the Board of Directors need not be given to any director who signs a waiver of notice either before or after the meeting. Attendance of a director at a meeting will constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting and waiver of any and all objections to the place of the meeting, the time of the meeting or the manner in which it has been called or convened, except when a director states, at the beginning of the meeting, any objection to the transaction of business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

Neither the business to be transacted nor the purpose of special or regular meetings of the Board of Directors need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting.

A majority of the voting directors present, whether or not a quorum exists, may adjourn any meeting of the Board of Directors to another time and place. Notice of any such adjourned meeting will be given to the directors who were not present at the time of the adjournment.

Meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the president of the corporation.

Members of the Board of Directors may participate in a meeting of such board by means of a conference telephone call or by similar means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at the meeting.

The President of the corporation, by virtue of the office, shall be the Chairperson of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may remove a director upon charges made to the Board by a voting member, in good standing in this organization. A director may be represented by counsel at any removal hearing. The Board of Directors may adopt such rules as it may, at its discretion, consider necessary for the best interests of the corporation, for this hearing. If the Board of Directors determines that there is good cause to remove said director from the board, then its determination shall be in writing stating, with specificity, the basis for the determination.

All business shall be conducted pursuant to Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE VII. ACTION TAKEN BY DIRECTORS WITHOUT A MEETING

Any action required or permitted by law to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors or a committee thereof, may be taken without a meeting if a written consent is filed setting forth the action so taken, and signed by all of the directors or all of the committee members, as the case may be, is filed in the minutes of the proceedings of the Board or of the committee. Such consent will have the same effect as a unanimous vote.

ARTICLE VIII. OFFICERS

The officers of this corporation are: President, Vice President - Division I, Vice President - Division II, Vice President - Referees, Vice President - Rules, Registrar, Secretary, Treasurer, and Immediate Past President. Each officer, with the exception of the Immediate Past President, will be elected or appointed by the Board of Directors from time to time. Any two or more officers' positions may be held by the same person. Each officer shall be elected at the annual general meeting for a one year term of office. Each voting Executive Officer shall receive an annual \$300 stipend subject to funds availability.

The officers of this corporation will have the following duties:

The President will be the chief executive officer of the corporation, who generally and actively manages the business and affairs of the corporation subject to the direction of the Board of Directors. The president shall preside at all membership meetings and is the Chairperson of the Board of Directors. The President shall present at each Annual General Meeting of the corporation an annual report of the work of the organization. The President shall appoint all committees, temporary or permanent, designate the committee chairperson with the Board's approval and serve as ex-officio member of all committees. The President shall see that all books, reports and certificates, as required by law .are properly kept or filed. The President shall be one of the officers who may sign checks for the corporation. This individual's singular signature, without counter signature, shall be sufficient on all checks not exceeding \$300.00. This individual also has the authority to co-sign checks exceeding \$300.00. The President is deemed to have all of the powers that may be reasonably construed as belonging to the chief executive officer of any corporation.

The Vice President - Division I shall be responsible for all matters effecting this division in early and regular season. He/she shall be responsible for establishing and maintaining a schedule of play for all teams in this division. This individual's singular signature, without counter signature, shall be sufficient on all checks not exceeding \$300.00. This individual also has the authority to co-sign checks exceeding \$300.00. In the event of the absence or inability of the President to exercise the powers of his/her office, he/she shall become the acting president of the organization with all rights, privileges and powers as if duly elected president.

The Vice President - Division II shall be responsible for all matters effecting this division in early and regular season. He/ she shall be responsible for establishing and maintaining a schedule of play for all teams in this division. In the event of the absence or inability of the President to exercise the powers of his/her office and the absence or inability of the Vice President - Division I to exercise the powers of his/her office, he/she shall become the acting Vice President - Division I and/or the acting president of the organization with all rights, privileges and powers as if duly elected.

The Vice President - Rules shall be responsible for: (a) reviewing all violations of the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws

and/or Rules and Regulations of this corporation; (b) reviewing any and all recommendations for amendments or repeal of any section or part of the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws and/or Rules and Regulations of this corporation and report on same to the Board of Directors; (c) the establishment of the playing rules for each playing season with the subsequent ratification of same by the Board of Directors; (d) the review of all disciplinary actions and recommend disciplinary measures to be assessed, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this corporation; (e) the review of all protests and appeals; and (f) the maintenance of a record of all disciplinary actions, protests and appeals. This officer shall not be a party to any appeal or protest hearing.

The Vice President - Referees shall: (a) be the liaison between the corporation and the local representatives of the referee's association; (b) coordinate between the corporation's referee assignors and the Vice Presidents of Divisions 1 and 2 in matters pertaining to referees; (c) communicate the corporation's playing rules to the referees; and, (d) maintain a record of all problems relating to referees.

The Registrar shall receive and maintain a current copy of the rosters of all teams prior to the start of any given playing season. The registrar shall also be responsible for receiving and maintaining a copy of all roster changes for any team during the course of any given season.

The Secretary shall keep the minutes and records of the corporation in appropriate books. This shall include such minutes from regularly scheduled meetings of the Board of Directors and of the membership of this corporation. It shall be the Secretary's duty to file any certificates required by any statute, federal, state, county or city. This individual shall give and serve all notices to members of this corporation and shall be the official custodian of the records and seal of this corporation.

The Secretary shall present to the membership at any meetings any communication addressed to that person as Secretary of the corporation and shall submit all such communications to the Board of Directors. The Secretary shall attend to all correspondence of the corporation and shall exercise all duties incident to the office of Secretary.

The Treasurer is the chief financial officer and shall have the care and custody of all monies in the corporation's accounts and shall oversee all expenditures made by the corporation. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain the financial books and records of this corporation and to examine all expenditures made to determine that said expenditures are within the corporation's operational budget. The Treasurer shall be one of the officers who may sign checks for the corporation. This individual's singular signature without counter signature, shall be sufficient in all checks not exceeding \$300.00. The Treasurer is deemed to have all of the powers that may be reasonably construed as belonging to the treasurer of a corporation.

The Immediate Past President is a honoraria, nonvoting position for a period of one year following the end of that individual's last term as president of this corporation.

An officer or agent elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed by the Board of Directors whenever in its judgment the best interests of the corporation will be served thereby.

Any vacancy in any office, with the exception of the Immediate Past President, may be filled by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX. BOOKS AND RECORDS

This corporation will keep accurate and complete books, records of account and minutes of proceedings of all meetings of the membership, Board of Directors and committees of directors.

The corporation will keep, at its registered office, principal place of business or office of its attorneys a record of all members.

Any books, records and minutes may be in written form or in any other form capable of being converted into written form.

Any organization which is a member of this corporation will have the right to examine in person or by agent or attorney, at any reasonable time, for any proper purpose, the corporation's relevant books, records of account, minutes and records of the membership.

Not later than three months after the close of each fiscal year, this corporation will prepare a balance sheet showing the financial condition of the corporation at the close of the fiscal year, and a profit and loss statement showing the results of the operations of the corporation during the fiscal year. The balance sheet and the profit and loss statement will be filed in the registered office of the corporation and will be kept for at least five years, and will be subject to inspection during business hours by any member in person or by agent.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be altered, amended or repealed pursuant to Article IX of the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE XI. IMPEACHMENTS, RESIGNATIONS AND EXPULSIONS

Any officer, director, or any other member of this organization may resign from their position or from this organization, upon either their own initiative or upon written request from the Board of Directors. Any officer, director or member may be removed from office or expelled from this organization by a 75% vote of all voting members of the Board of Directors at either a regular or special meeting held for the express purpose of removing and/or expelling any officer, director or member of the organization for conduct either unbecoming or prejudicial to the stated aims or purposes of this corporation. A director or a member of the Board of Directors may also be impeached for failing to attend meetings of the Board of Directors. Notice of any Board meeting for the purpose of removing and/or expelling a director, officer or member, or the removal of an individual from

office must be mailed, by certified mail, to all Directors and to the party or parties involved not less than 14 days prior to the date set for said meeting. Any officer and/or director who is impeached, who may resign, or who becomes unable to perform the duties and responsibilities of their office, except for the President of the corporation, shall be replaced by an individual elected by a simple majority vote of all voting members of the Board of Directors. If the President is impeached, resigns or if the President becomes unable to perform his/her duties on a permanent basis, then the right to succession herein before set forth shall apply.

ARTICLE XII. CORPORATE INDEMNIFICATION PLAN

The corporation shall indemnify any person:

1. Who is a party, or is threatened to be made a party, to any pending or threatened suit, proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of, this corporation) by reason of the fact that he is or was a director or officer of the corporate or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as director or officer of another corporate association or other enterprise against such costs and expenses, and to the extent and in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Florida.

2. Who is a party or is threatened to be made a party, to any pending or threatened action or suit by or in the right of the corporation to procure a judgment in its favor by reason of the fact that he is or was a director or officer of the corporation or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director or officer of another corporation, association or other enterprise against such costs and expenses, and to the extent and in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Florida.

The extent, amount and eligibility for the indemnification provided herein will be made by the Board of Directors. Such determination will be made by a majority vote of a quorum of directors who were not parties to such action, suit or proceeding, or by the membership if all of the directors are parties to such action, suit or proceeding.

The corporation shall not indemnify a director or officer for their own gross negligence, willful misconduct or intentional torts.

The corporation is further authorized to purchase and maintain insurance for indemnification of any person as provided herein.
